


Welcome

Did you know?

RaptorMed automates many tasks to save you time!

Add auto-repeating reminders:

Repeating reminders are very helpful in cases where you don't know how long something will need to be done or in cases where something should be done periodically forever. In the patients chart, click **Add Reminder** in the **Action Bar**. Enter some text in the **Task** field, and choose **Daily auto-repeat**. The reminder will now appear every day until it is removed. You can also have reminders repeat on a day of the week or a day of the month.

For enclosures, from the main screen right click on **Enclosure List** ► **Add Reminder**. For general purpose reminders select **Edit** ► **Add Reminder** from the main menu.

Use Auto-Generated E-mails:

There are many instances when you need to send reports to different agencies. When a patient is admitted because of an illegal activity such as a gunshot wound, the US FWS must be notified.

To automatically send them a report right click on the patient in the patient list in the main window; choose **Paperwork ▶ Illegal Cause of Injury E-mail.** A form will appear with a pre-written/addressed e-mail containing specific information about the patient of interest. The message can be edited if desired and then click **Send** when read to submit.


View Weight Chart For Individual or Group:

For a quick "Snapshot" of an individual patients weight profile **Shift-right click** on the patient on the main screen.



To generate the weight trend for a whole enclosure go to the **Location List**, right

click on the desired location then select **Show Weight Trends**. The most recent weight of an individual patient can be viewed by clicking on any point in the graph.
